The Union forces were able to obtain a wealth of intelligence information from the ship. Smalls later was made the first African-American Captain in the US Navy and later went on to be a member of the U.S. House of Representatives. A fascinating story. Following his presentation, Mike presented Capt. Kittler with the NWFMOA challenge coin.

Mike then asked the Officers and Board or members present if there were any comments. Dave Parisot announced the newest members of the Scholarship Fund's Gold Century Club.
